An author's guideline is being prepared but interim manuscripts can be submitted in MS Word, PDF, or Apple Pages. Color graphics or motion video are welcomed as part of the manuscript package. Graphics should be in JPEG or PNG format at a minimum resolution of 300 dpi. Video should be in MPEG, MOV, or MP4 format at a minimum resolution of 720p (1280 x 720). A formal sheet of standards is forthcoming on the website.
